



Henderson now offers acupuncture at St. Helena Hospital

Dr. Chris Henderson, a licensed acupuncturist and naturopathic doctor, recently began providing acupuncture services at St. Helena Hospital's Martin O'Neil Cancer Center. This service is part of the new "community acupuncture" program in the cancer center. It is a pilot program funded through St. Helena Hospital, a news release said.

Community acupuncture differs from traditional individual "one on one" acupuncture in that people are treated in a group environment, the release said.

A typical community acupuncture session costs \$20 per session, the release said.

"I am very excited to have these doors opening for licensed acupuncturists within our Napa Valley hospitals," said Dr. Henderson.

Henderson also has offices in Napa at Queen of the Valley Wellness Center's Institute of Integrative Health and in Calistoga at the Optimal Health Center.
